Sports Premium 2013-2014

For the next three academic years the government is spending over £450 million on improving physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools.

Schools can choose how they use the funding, for example to:

- hire specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work with primary teachers during PE lessons
- support and involve the least active children by running after-school sports clubs, holidays clubs etc.
- provide resources and training courses in PE and sport for teachers

How St John the Evangelist Catholic Academy is spending the grant:

After completing an audit of PE and sports provision in the school and discussions within staff meetings, it was felt that our school priority was to develop the knowledge, skills and capacity of the school's teaching staff to enable them to deliver high quality gymnastics lessons.

We have therefore sourced an experienced P.E. teacher to come in and plan, model and team-teach high quality PE Lessons with teaching staff.

We also allocated some monies to provide an after school club for Pupil Premium children.

In 2013/14 we will receive £5,300 in funding. Below is a summary of our planned expenditure.

- Cost of buying- in an experienced P.E. teacher - £5,213
- After school club - £50.00
