Below are some ideas for your child's homework. **These can be completed in any order** and evidenced in your child's homework book (for example, your child's writing, your comments, pictures, photographs or sentences of things you have made or done). Please reference your child's homework with a title and the homework number it corresponds to. We want your child to be proud of their work so please encourage them to do their best work in all the tasks. Homework books will be given out on **Wednesday** and need to be bought back to school on the following **Wednesday** for marking.

1	<p><b>Transport</b></p> <p>Can your child look at different means of transport? What is their favourite and why? Can they look at old and new transport and compare? Why are they different? How have they evolved?</p>			
2	<p><b>Purple Mash</b></p> <p><a href="https://www.purplemash.com/stjohn-st7">https://www.purplemash.com/stjohn-st7</a></p> <p>Can your child complete the set '2do' on their portal and write a postcard about any experience or holiday you can think of? Think about where you were, who it is for and what you are going to write about. Go on your child's portal using their login and complete their work using '2do' and click on the work set.</p>			
3	<p><b>Shape</b></p> <p>Can your child compose and decompose shapes so that they recognise that a shape can have other shapes within it, just as numbers can. For example two squares together make a rectangle, six triangles make a hexagon ext.</p>			
4	<p><b>Holidays!</b></p> <p>Talk about your favourite holiday you have been on or where you would like to go or where you are going! Why would you like to go there? Draw a picture of your chosen place and write some information about it.</p>			

5	<p align="center"><b>Summer treat designs!</b></p> <p>Design your own refreshing summer treat. Think about what you like (ice cream, ice lolly, fruit, jelly etc.) and then create your own! Draw a picture, label and write 2 sentences about why people should buy your treat. We might even make some of these designs in class!</p>			
6	<p align="center"><b>Sentence Writing</b></p> <p>Independently - can your child write a couple of sentences (using their phonics - words do not need to be spelt correctly) about a memory or their favourite toy - anything that interests them ensuring they use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops?</p>			
7	<p align="center"><b>Odds and Evens</b></p> <p>Can you child tell you what an odd and even number is? Can they write them down to twenty and notice the pattern? (Can they see that with odd numbers there will never be a complete pair - 1 will always be left over? Can they see that evens follow the two times table - and will always have a pair/ partner?)</p>			
8	<p align="center"><b>Phonics</b></p> <p><b>From now and in the 6 weeks holidays can you please learn and remember all of your diagraphs (phase 3 sounds) - If parents need help with pronunciation there are lots of clips on youtube under jolly phonics phase 3! - Here is the list below</b> qu, sh, ch, th, ng, ai, ee, igh, oa, oo, oo, or, ar, ur, ow, oi, ear, air, ure, er. They will need to know these ready for year 1!</p>			

**Remember:**

1. Homework should be quality time for you and your child to share experiences and to ensure that we are involving you in your child's learning.
2. Have high expectations (you know what your child is capable of)
3. Always praise your child for their efforts.
4. Your child's writing must be written in **pencil**, not pen.
5. Please help and guide your child but do not do it for them.
