The results of our recent pupil voice questionnaire were extremely positive. The results have been analysed so that we can further improve our provision at St John's.

1) The school understands my needs:

**Results show that the staff at St John's really do know the children and their needs and that the children recognise this. The children understand that at times they require support and they feel that this support is given to them by the staff. New children to the school soon settle with the support given to them.**
